

KIDS COMMUNITY GROUP LESSON (I WILL KEEP A GOOD ATTITUDE AND NOT COMPLAIN)

Leader's Guide

Bible Lesson:

Give background information on God calling Moses to lead the Israelites out of slavery and into the promised land (Exodus 3). Read Numbers 16 from a children's Bible or story Bible. Stop throughout the story to check for understanding. After reading through the story, discuss God' leading and how many opportunities the complainers had to do the right thing.

Discussion Questions:

- Who put Moses and Aaron in charge of the Israelites when they escaped from slavery in Egypt?
- Who was Korah and why did he begin to complain? How did all the other leaders start to get upset with Moses and Aaron?
- How did the complaining leaders remember their time in Egypt? What were they forgetting?
- God wants us to speak blessing over others. Complaining about someone is the opposite of blessing them. Did Moses try to speak blessing or save God's people even after they complained about him?
- After reading this story, do you think God wants us to have a complaining spirit?

As Christians, God wants us to work hard to keep a good attitude and not complain. Talk about situations that make us want to complain. Discuss area in children's lives where they might be tempted to get whiney and complain to others.
