Bible Lesson:

In Daniel 4, King Nebuchadnezzar told his people about the amazing things God had done in his life. He had been a very powerful king with a huge kingdom and lots of riches but he wasn't following God. One day he had a dream that scared him. He asked lots of fortune tellers and magicians what it meant. Then he remember that Daniel was filled with the Holy Spirit and asked him interpret the dream.

Read Daniel 4:24-37. For older children, read all of Chapter 4 to get the full story. This would be a good story to retell by acting it out or drawing a cartoon version. Re-teaching or retelling a lesson is the best way for a child to show they understand the meaning and commit the information to memory.

Discussion Questions:

- Why did King Nebuchadnezzar seek out Daniel's help?
- Describe the dream he had.
- Was Daniel worried for the king? Why?
- What did Daniel tell King Nebuchadnezzar to do?
- What happened to the king?
- When he came back to his kingdom, who did Nebuchadnezzar worship?
- Why do you think King Nebuchadnezzar wanted to tell the people of his kingdom about this terrible time in his life?
