Ezekiel 36:24-28 MSG For here's what I'm going to do: I'm going to...give you a new heart, put a new spirit in you. I'll remove the stone heart from your body and replace it with...my Spirit...You'll be my people! I'll be your God!

3. How well am I _____ my new heart?

Psalms 119:32 NIV I run in the path of Your commands, for You have set my heart free.
