Mother's Day is a great time to reflect on relationships in our lives. Regardless of age, we all have influence with someone. How are we using that influence? It takes bravery to teach others the best for their lives by the way we live our own. Together we can raise a brave generation of people for Jesus resulting in *Changing lives that impact the world.*

Read Exodus 2:1-4. Discuss as a group these events and how you may have felt in the same situation. How can you relate to letting go of something significant in your life and trusting God?

Read Romans 5:3-5. How do you typically respond when troubles come your way? Where are you in this list of traits? What can help you move to the next one? How can the group help?

Read Exodus 2:5-9. Discuss how the rest of this story played out. Share a story of how God has brought the right person into your life when you needed it. Share a story of how God has used you in the life of someone else.

Read Isaiah 55:8-9 and Proverbs 3:5-6. What areas have been difficult for you to trust God in? Why? Share a time you put your trust in God more than your own understanding and watched God show up.

Read Deuteronomy 31:6 and Hebrews 11:23. Raising a brave generation of people for Jesus requires trusting God and living by faith. It's never too early and it's never too late to start being a brave influence. Who are the people you are investing in today? Who do you need to begin investing in?

Keep praying. Pray for God to help you grow so that you can lead others toward the best life God has for them.
