God, Christianity, and Hearing Him

May 24, 2015

You asked for it. We have questions that we've been waiting for someone in the church to talk about, and now is the time. Throughout this series we'll answer the questions that YOU want answered. Now is the time for answers.

How would you describe God to someone? What is the most difficult part of trying to explain God?

Read these verses one at a time and discuss what they teach us about who God is (John 14:6, Isaiah 64:8, 1 John 3:1a, John 3:16, John 1:14, John 16:7, and Romans 8:26). How do these things distinguish the God of the Bible from all other gods?

How have you experienced God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit in your life? How would you say your life reflects living by Holy Spirit power according to Galatians 5:13-26. Which aspect of God do you need more of right now? Why?

Read John 10:4, Hebrews 4:12, and James 3:17. God's voice can be heard many ways, but most often through His Word and by Holy Spirit. Share a story of hearing God's voice. What is it you need to hear from God today? As a group, look into God's Word for the things your hearts desire to hear. You may refer to verses you have memorized, to a topical index in your Bible, or Google to help.

Read Psalm 46:10. Take time as a group to simply be still and acknowledge the truth and majesty of God above all other things. Share things you feel were God's voice speaking during that time.

Pray for a deeper understanding of God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit and how each demonstrates His love and desire for us to experience life abundantly. Pray for a greater desire to hear God's voice each day of His love and to guide us so we can *Live Fully Alive*.
