



## Group Lesson

### *Marriage, Divorce, & Sexuality*

June 14, 2015

*You asked for it. We have questions that we've been waiting for someone in the church to talk about, and now is the time. Throughout this series we'll answer the questions that YOU want answered. Now is the time for answers.*

Read Philippians 1:9-10. How has this series helped you in your knowledge and understanding of living a pure and blameless life? Has love been the overflow of this growth? Explain.

Read Matthew 19:3-9 and Hebrews 13:4. Discuss why you think divorce is so common in our culture today. How do you think God's Word impacts that trend? Share with the group how you have seen God's truth and love strengthen a marriage.

Read 1 Corinthians 6:9-11. Give some reasons why people struggle to remove these things from their lives and experience the best God has for them. Have any of these areas kept you from living fully alive and having the promise of eternity with God? Are you currently missing out on all God has for you? What can change that? How can the group help? Share with the group the difference it has made since you have gone all in for Jesus.

Read 2 Timothy 2:5, Romans 8:13, Romans 8:15. Is your life more directed by your flesh (your desires and power) or God's Spirit (God's desires and power)? Share how Holy Spirit has empowered your life.

Read 1 Corinthians 13:13. How does your life reflect this verse? How can it?

Pray together. Seek God to help everyone experience the love of God regardless of past or current circumstances. Seek Holy Spirit for power to live according to God's truth and be known for their love.
