Bible Lesson:

Have you ever been told by a teacher or a parent to do something a certain way but you decided to do it your way and it turned out bad?

Read: King Saul went through very dark times when he wasn't obeying God. He was angry, mean, jealous and evil. Jesus had righteous anger and that is the only kind that honors God. Read to see the difference: **1 Samuel 15:10-11, 1 Samuel 16:14-23, 1 Samuel 18:6-16, Ephesians 4:1-5, Ephesians 4:25-32**

Discussion Questions:

2. What happened to him after God turned away?
3. How did David help Saul get out of his terrible moods?
4. What made Saul jealous and angry with David?
5. Why didn't David act the same way toward Saul?
6. Name some ways Jesus said we could create unity with others?
7. Is it normal to get angry? What should we avoid when we feel angry?
8. Why should we forgive others?
