Read Mark 10:13-16. As a parent (if applicable), what are ways you bring your children to Jesus? As a follower of Jesus (parent or not), what are ways you invest in children? Did you go to church as a child? What was your experience? How has that impacted your view of investing in kids through the church today?

In this passage Jesus talks about receiving His Kingdom like a child. What does that look like for you? What do you believe is the difference between childish and childlike?

Read Psalm 78:1-8 and Proverbs 22:6. These passages detail the importance and promise of not mere intentions, but words and actions. What is one way you can begin investing in the next generation this week, knowing it could change the history of at least one? How will you hold each other accountable as a group?

Pray together that we would invest in the next generation, see them love Jesus and never walk away from Him!
