How have culture, personal desires, and need for more money impacted your life? Read the following verses and share your thoughts and how these truths could change things. 1 Timothy 6:10, Proverbs, 10:22, Proverbs 3:9-10, Matthew 23:23

Tithing is giving the first 10% of your finances to God out of love and trust. Discuss barriers to tithing. What has been your journey to trusting God with your finances? Is tithing and/or doing finances God's way a door you need to walk through today?

Tithing is trusting God more than money. Share how you have seen God work in your life after trusting Him in this area. What other doors may open as you demonstrate more trust in God with your finances.

Pray for financial breakthroughs in the group. Pray for greater trust in God with money and to see His faithfulness.
