KIDS COMMUNITY GROUP LESSON (WITH GOD I'M OKAY, NO MATTER WHAT OTHERS SAY!)

Leader's Guide for groups occurring October 24th to October 30th

Bible Lesson:

Do you ever worry about what other people think of you? Do you like to wear fashionable clothes, do certain sports, or say the right things to fit in with other kids? Give some examples and ask if they are affected by peer pressure. Remind the kids that it is human nature to be concerned about what others think about you, but in the end, what matters is what God think.

*God called Moses in an amazing way. He wanted Moses to lead the Israelites out of slavery. Even though God talked to him in this unbelievable manner, Moses still worried about what others would think of him. He even tried to come up with excuses to get out of following God's commands. Read **Exodus 3**.*

Discussion Questions:

- What was Moses doing when an angel appeared to him?
- When Moses answered, what did God tell him to do?
- Why did Moses hide his face?
- Why had God decided to help the Israelites?
- What was He going to give them?
- Who did God want Moses to talk to about letting the Israelites go?
- When Moses was afraid, how did God reassure him?
- What name did God tell Moses to use if the people asked who sent him?
- How was God going to convince Pharaoh to let the Israelites go?
- Would you listen to God if He told you to do something? Do you listen to Him now when He speaks to you through His word?
