Read Ephesians 4:29-32. All healthy relationships stem from both people becoming more holy together. What things in this passage challenge you? Which one(s) can you begin to change this week? How?

Pray that God would change our hearts, minds, and character to help us become more of who He desires for us to be. Pray for each other to experience the fullness of relationships the way God intended.
