In what ways can you make your spouse's sexual fulfillment a priority? What obstacles get in the way of making your sex life satisfying for both of you?

What commitments do you need to make for your sexuality to be God-honoring?

What will you do to get past any hurts or brokenness from the past to move forward God's way?
