Leader's Guide for groups occurring January 16th to 22nd

Bible Lesson:

Ask the children to tell all they remember about Joseph's story in the Bible. Have you ever had a dream that confused you, and you just had to ask other people what they thought about it?

*Joseph survived being thrown in a well and sold into slavery, only to be thrown in prison in Egypt. Somehow, Joseph continued to have faith and depended on God to give him all he needed to survive. Joseph had no idea that prison would be the place where God would use him in a way that would eventually change his whole life. **Read Genesis 41** or read the story of Joseph interpreting Pharaoh's dreams while in prison.*

Discussion Questions:

- Who dreamed about the seven fat, healthy cows and the seven skinny, scrawny cows?
- What was Pharaoh's second dream about?
- Who did Pharaoh first call on when he was disturbed about his dream? How did Joseph get called to see Pharaoh?
- When asked if he could interpret dreams, what was Joseph's response?
- What did Joseph believe Pharaoh's dreams meant? Why did Pharaoh appoint Joseph ruler over Egypt?
- What events happened just as Joseph predicted?
- Joseph must've felt so alone in prison, but what happened that made people from all around come to him?
- What do you think God is preparing you for in the future? Are you letting Him make you more like Jesus, so you'll be ready to follow His amazing plan?
