I'll Believe More In What I Can't See, Than What I Can See!

Leader's Guide for groups occurring January 23rd to 29th

Bible Lesson:

Have the children act out or retell the story of Moses. What is something you are sure you could never do because of your fear or lack of talent, etc.?

Moses followed God, but still had a difficult time believing what he couldn't see or understand. Read Exodus 3-4:17 or the story of Moses and the burning bush in a Children's Bible.

Discussion Questions:

- What did Moses do when the angel of the Lord appeared to him in the middle of a burning bush?
- When God called Moses' name, what did He tell Moses to do?
- Why did God say He was coming to rescue His people?
- What job did He tell Moses to do?
- Could Moses see himself doing what God told him to do?
- Who was Moses supposed to say had sent him to rescue God's people?
- What was God going to do to force Pharaoh to listen to Moses?
- What did God do when Moses continued to doubt Him?
- When Moses begged God not to make him speak, what did God do?
- Will you believe God can do amazing things with your life even when you can't really imagine, or see it yet?
