Leader's Guide for groups occurring February 7th to 12th

Bible Lesson:

Have the children tell the story of David and Goliath. Talk about what they learned in Community Kids, or read the story from a Children's Bible. **Read 1 Samuel 17.**

You may know the story of David and Goliath. Goliath was the Philistines' champion, and the Israelites were terrified of him. David knew that God was with him, and because of that, he wasn't afraid of the giant!

Discussion Questions:

- Why were the Israelites afraid of Goliath?
- Why was David on the battlefield?
- What did David's brothers say to him?
- What did David decide to do when he heard Goliath yelling?
- What did King Saul tell David?
- What did David do with the armor that King Saul gave him?
- What did Goliath say to David? What did David say back to Goliath?
- How did David defeat Goliath?
- David knew that God was with him. How can you know that God is with you?
