Key Scriptures:

Matthew 7:1-5
2 Corinthians 3:13-18

Other Verses:

Ephesians 4:15
Psalm 139:23-24

Key Points:

- We must be known to have relationships.
- I can live to impress people, or connect with people.
- The only way to receive the love you need is to be the real you.
- God's grace can only stick to what you're willing to reveal.

Share a story of an embarrassing moment from the past.

Explain why that same situation would, or would not, be as embarrassing today.

Tell the group about the person you would say knows you best.

How did they get to know you so well? How does that impact the relationship you have?

Are you more likely to share what you are dealing with or point out the struggles of others? Why?

How has that affected the relationships you have? Is there anything about your approach that should change? Explain.

Have you focused more on impressing or connecting with people in the past/today?

What would be different if your approach was more focused on connecting? What makes this difficult to do? How can you improve this?

What are some of the “veils” you wear? How can the group help you remove them?

What makes it difficult for you to reveal things to God?

Read Psalm 139:23-24 together.

Take time to individually reflect on these verses. Then be vulnerable, by sharing with the group, what God has revealed to you.

Pray for one another about what God has revealed. Pray words of encouragement and to experience His grace.
