Jesus Is King of My Life!

Leader's Guide for groups occurring March 20th to March 25th

Bible Lesson:

Describe what you think of when you hear the word "King". If the children only have a few ideas, ask questions like: "Would a king have lots of money, or just a little? Do kings wear raggedy clothes or beautiful purple robes?"

*Let's read about the day Jesus entered Jerusalem before He was arrested and crucified. But first, read in the Old Testament about the prophet who foretold what would happen. Read **Zechariah 9:9-10**. Now read Matthew's account of what Jesus did that day (**Matthew 21:1-11**).*

Discussion Questions:

- What did Jesus tell his disciples to do when they approached Jerusalem?
- What did Jesus tell them to say if the owner didn't want them to take the donkey or the colt?
- Why did all this take place? Why didn't Jesus just walk into town?
- What did the people do when they heard Jesus was coming?
- How did the crowd react when they saw Jesus?
- When Jesus arrived in Jerusalem, what question was everyone asking?
- How did the crowds answer this question?
- If Jesus came into your city, how would you answer the questions, *Who is that?*
- Jesus came into Jerusalem on a lowly donkey as an example to us. How will you serve others the way Jesus served you?

"Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion. Shout, Daughter Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and victorious, lowly and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey."
