Leader's Guide for groups occurring June 4th through June 10th

Bible Lesson:

What is the best thing about having a good friend? Tell about a time when you felt like you had no friends. What was it like?

*Daniel loved God with all his heart, but he still went through some very lonely times. Daniel could always rely on God to be his best friend because he always made time to pray. Even though he had many lonely times imprisoned and away from all his family and friends, God was with him and used him in a mighty way! **Read Daniel 5.***

Discussion Questions:

- What did King Belshazzar ask his servants to do during his banquet?
- Why was it bad for him to use those cups?
- How did the King react when he saw the hand on the wall?
- Describe the people King Belshazzar asked to help him understand the writing on the wall.
- What was the prize for the one who could explain the writing on the wall?
- How did the queen describe what Daniel could do?
- What did the King say about Daniel?
- What did Daniel say about the King's gifts?
- How did Daniel explain the mysterious writing on the wall?
- Since God was with Daniel and gave him all he needed to explain the writings, what did the King do for Daniel?
