Leader's Guide for groups occurring July 30th through August 5th

Bible Lesson:

Think about the biggest and strongest storm that you have ever seen. How did you feel during the storm? Did you feel afraid?

*The Bible tells us that God is able to protect us when we face storms in life; not only thunderstorms, but also all the other trials that we go through in life. Jesus showed us this one time when he was in the middle of a storm with his disciples. They were all on the sea in a boat and suddenly a great storm came upon them. The disciples were very afraid and worried for their lives. However, Jesus was resting in the bottom of the boat. Jesus knew that God could protect them through the storm. God can also give us courage when we face storms in life. He is able to protect us and help us when we need him. **Read Mark 4:35-41.***

Discussion Questions:

- In the story, where did Jesus and the disciples go?
- What happened on their journey?
- How did the disciples respond to the storm?
- How was Jesus' response different than the disciples?
- What did Jesus do after the disciples woke him up?
- How did the disciples feel after Jesus calmed the storm?
- Have you ever felt afraid like the disciples in the storm?
- What is one thing in your life right now where you need God's help?
- In what ways can God help you in your need?
