Leader's Guide for groups occurring August 13th through August 19th

Bible Lesson:

Joseph was a man who never stopped trusting in God and serving Him, even though many ups and downs. He endured being thrown into a well and sold into slavery only to be put in prison in Egypt. Joseph continued to have faith in God to give him all that he needed to survive. Joseph had no idea that prison would be the place where God would use him in a way that would eventually change his whole life. God had a great plan for Joseph's life and all Joseph had to do was keep on believing and trusting in Him.

Read Genesis 41 or read the story of Joseph interpreting the Pharaoh's dreams while in prison in a Children's Bible.

Discussion Questions:

1. Who dreamed about the seven fat, healthy cows and seven skinny, scrawny cows?
2. What was Pharaoh's second dream about?
3. Who did Pharaoh first call on when he was disturbed about the dreams?
4. How did Joseph get called to see Pharaoh?
5. What did Joseph say when asked if he could interpret dreams?
6. How did Joseph describe what Pharaoh's dreams meant?
7. What events happened as Joseph had predicted?
8. How was Joseph rewarded for trusting God and doing what God told him to do?
9. What trials are you pushing through with the trust that God will give you all that you need to make it?
10. Are you trying to live like Jesus everyday so He can use you in a mighty way too?
