Leader's Guide for groups occurring September 24th through September 30th

Bible Lesson:

Do you have people in your life that you get along with no matter what? Do you know people in your life that are much more difficult to get along with? Oftentimes, we can easily show God's love to the people that we naturally get along with. However, God asks us to love all people – even those who we normally don't spend time with and even those that we maybe don't like as much as our close friends. This may seem difficult at times, but God's love changes everything! With his help, we can love all people, even our enemies. Read Luke 10:30-37.

Discussion Questions:

1. What happened to the first man who was traveling home?
2. What did the priest and Levite do when they passed him?
3. What did the Samaritan do when he passed him?
4. How did the Samaritan go above and beyond in helping the man?
5. Why is it surprising that the priest and the Levite didn't stop for the man?
6. Do you think you would have stopped and helped the stranger? Why or why not?
7. Why is it sometimes difficult to love strangers and those we aren't friends with?
8. Why is it important that we show love to those people even when it's hard?
9. Who are some people in your life that you could show God's love to more?
10. How can God help you love those who are more difficult to love?
